A General Work Experience course may only be taken one time.

## WRKX 303: Occupational Work Experience

Units of credit are awarded on the basis of number of hours of employment per week and the successful completion of learning objectives. Students may not enroll in more than sixteen (16) units that are directly related to occupational work experience, whether from one department or from multiple departments, or general work experience.
