

2016-17 INSTITUTIONAL EFFECTIVENESS GOALS FRAMEWORK
West Valley College and the West Valley -Mission Community College District

Background : In 2014, the California legislature established a system of indicators and goals that is intended to encourage improvement in institutional effectiveness at California community colleges. Pursuant to Education Code section 84754.6, the Board of Governors (BOG) adopted the YearTwo goals framework at its November 16, 2015 meeting to measure the ongoing condition of receipt of Student Success and Support Programs, each college develop, adopt and post a goals framework that addresses, at a minimum, the following four areas: performance and outcomes, accreditation status, fiscal viability, and programmatic compliance with state and federal guidelines. In accordance with statute, the Chancellor will also post system wide goals adopted by the BOG along with the locally developed and adopted college/district goals by Thursday, June 30, 2016.

Adopting Framework and Year -Two Goals : Each college should adopt the framework of indicators approved by the BOG, and colleges/districts should adopt short-term (1-year) and long-term (6-year) goals for each of the YearTwo Indicator Portal. In addition to the required goals
