



The Chancellor's determination is a location as this and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and conflict of interest code (Gov. Code Section 81008).


## APPENDIX B

### DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES



NOTE: This section has been omitted under one of the following facts essentially verbatim from Title 2 Sections 18730 et seq. The number system and the system used in the code. This information is included for convenience reference.

Section 4. Submission of Statements by Employees. The code-reviewing body shall instruct all designated employees Place of Filing. The agents of an agency in contact with the executive branch within its code to file statements with the code-reviewing body in the agency's conflict of interest code. The Executive Agent shall instruct the heads of the executive branch agencies to furnish the executive branch offices concerned with the collection of statements from covered employees in their areas and forwarding them to collecting the statements o



~~any confirmation or appointment, or the date of consideration, or change in position during the 12 months prior to the date of assuming office or the date of leaving office, or any other relevant information on the separate schedule.~~

(C) Contents of Annual Statements. Annual statements shall disclose any reportable investments, interests in real property, income and business positions held or maintained by the employee during the period of time that the employee was employed by the agency. The annual statement must begin no later than October of the year in which the date of separation from employment occurs.

~~all officers, employees and agents of the Commission shall file annually, by January 15th of each year, a statement of all assets and liabilities, including debts, due to him or her, and the filing date of the last statement filed and the date of leaving office.~~
